



REPEAL OF THE BOIL WATER NOTICE

TO

THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF WALHALLA WATER DEPARTMENT

August 15, 2021

The City of Walhalla Water Department advises the residents of the Walhalla Water System, located in Oconee County that they no longer need to boil their water prior to drinking or cooking.

Following an intense flushing of the distribution system, bacteriological samples were collected and analyzed by the City of Walhalla Water Department. The results of this sampling indicate that the system is now safe to use for drinking and cooking purposes.
