### WALHALLA GREENWAY PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

(Walhalla, SC) October 6, 2021. The City of Walhalla along with its design partners GMC and Studio Main will be unveiling the proposed Phase 1 of the Walhalla Greenway at the Walhalla Depot on October 14, 2021 from 4PM-6PM. The City of Walhalla was awarded a grant for design and construction of the Walhalla Greenway in mid-2020. The Walhalla Greenway, Phase I, will begin on Coffee Rd. and end near the Depot. The project will construct 4,250 linear feet of pedestrian and bicycle path in downtown Walhalla. The overall greenway project is approximately 3.25 miles will be constructed on North and South Broad Streets. The walking and biking trail will consist of public art, interactive features along with expanding the City's beautification program by adding an arboretum like component.

The public is invited to make comments and/or suggestions on the proposed project. Public comment periods will be October 14, 2021 until November 3, 2021.
