A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT A MUNICIPAL JUDGE

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code of Laws §14-25 allows for municipalities to establish their own courts and provides direction of administration thereof; and

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code of Laws §14-25-5 directs municipalities to provide for the appointment of one or more judges; and

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code of Laws §14-25-15 directs that municipalities must appoint judges for terms of not less than two years and no more than four years; and

WHEREAS; The City of Walhalla has established a municipal court by Ordinances 1976-11 and 1981-1; and

WHEREAS, the City of Walhalla desires to appoint judges to adjudicate its laws and ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Walhalla, South Carolina, in regular meeting duly assembled, a quorum being present that:

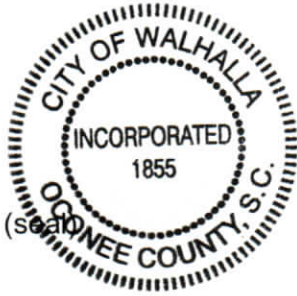
Section 1. Roberta Barton, is hereby appointed as a part-time municipal judge and Robert Owens, is also appointed as a part-time associate municipal judge.


Section 2. The City Administrator and City Clerk shall take such actions necessary to coordinate the appointments of the municipal judge.
